Steere House is pleased to present our Annual Report for 2020.

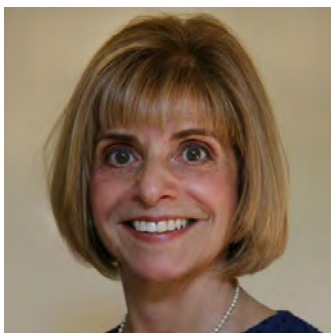

Treasurer's Report

Steere House Nursing & Rehabilitation Center and Steere House Foundation

Combined Balance Sheet | December 31, 2020

This condensed information has been abstracted from our 2020 audited financial statements.

The total net operating revenue for Medicare, Medicaid, commercial insurers, and private pay residents was \$9,870,919 compared to operating expenses of \$13,266,947 for an operating loss of \$3,396,028. (This compares to a 2019 operating loss of \$1,597,632.) However, other income of \$3,640,473, which included net investment gains of \$1,957,773 and COVID-19 grants of \$1,010,990, resulted in a net gain of \$244,445 in 2020 compared to a net gain of \$1,674,118 in 2019.
