Dear Residents and Family Members,

As you already know, Steere House is vigilant and tests for COVID-19 regularly. The Rhode Island Department of Health has been very clear and strict regarding the identification of even a SINGLE test which results in a positive COVID-19 result. Our Rhode Island community at large is opening up and with that event comes some risk, no matter how careful and scrupulous Steere House may be.

When such a result is reported, visitation must be limited again to DRIVE-BY with appointment only. Today, Steere House has learned of a positive test result. Families who had an in-person appointment planned were all called this morning by staff from either the Activity Department or Social Work Department. This decision is one which is difficult to make but Steere House is required to do so.
