What a different letter this is as compared to the communication in July 2020. I am grateful that we have vaccines and supplies and mostly – for the loyal families and staff of Steere House.

Please note the following reminders about visitation:

- We encourage visits outdoors as much as possible and weather permitting.
- HOURS DAILY:
 - 10 am to 12: noon and
 - 2 pm to 6pm
- NO wandering through a resident area or into other resident rooms if indoors. Visitors/Guests are restricted to the resident room of the individual they are visiting.
- All visitors must wear a surgical mask (we are happy to provide).
- All visitors will be screened at the entryway. Please note that visits will not be allowed if anyone is showing symptoms of illness.
- All visitors must agree to monitor themselves for signs and symptoms for 14 days after leaving the facility, and if symptoms develop they must self-isolate at home, contact their health care provider, and inform Steere House immediately.

Steere House continues to participate in Rhode Island Department of Health update communication and will make changes to our policies accordingly. I do not anticipate any significant changes over the summer. Please consider the vaccine if you have not already done so. Thank you.
