Dear Family Members and Friends of Steere House,

I am pleased to report a successful round of testing last week, no positives!

Spring officially arrived over the weekend, and Easter Celebrations will be quite early this year. This letter's focus is to share some information with you regarding logistics.

If you are considering taking your loved one home for an Easter Sunday visit, please keep these points in mind. I know for some families, the opportunity to have this type of special visit is greatly anticipated and will be a joyous occasion. Thank you in advance for the attention to this guidance which Steere House must follow and you must attest to:

- a. The RI Dept. of Health (RIDOH) guidance is clear – “household to household” visitation only. This means that Easter meals in a restaurant are not permitted.
- b. Individuals currently in quarantine may not travel to a home or household per RIDOH.
- c. No more than 15 total individuals in a community household, the host home.
- d. No walk in requests to take your loved one home please.

Visitation:

1. Visit reservations/appointments will begin Easter at 11:00am.
2. No walk in visitation on Easter, as is required by RIDOH, appointments only.

- a. Time of pick up/return
- b. Who is coming to pick up/return with contact cell phone number
- c. Request Notification Deadline: Wednesday, March 31.

Of course, our culinary services team will be planning a special menu for Easter which we will share next week. While caution is still our mantra, it is wonderful to enjoy this time of renewal and visits with family which can benefit our residents so very much!
