Dear Friends and Family Members,

Steere House is once more updating our visitor guidance! We appreciate your cooperation as we take one step at a time to be sure you can visit and that all our community is proceeding safely. PLEASE share this information with other family members. We ask families to plan with one another regarding visits.

All changes begin on Thursday, May 27th.

Appointments are NO longer required for routine visits:

*Visiting Hours are:

10:00 am - 12:00 pm

(Preferred Outdoor: Activity Rm. lawn area)

2:00 pm – 6:00 pm

(Preferred Outdoor: Courtyard via the first fl. Dining Rm.)

*Outdoor visits: When possible, visitation outdoors is preferred. Outdoor visits have a 4 guest maximum.

Masks may be removed outside only during visits when **Residents AND Visitors** are fully vaccinated.

Social distancing of 3 feet is required if both the resident and visitor are vaccinated.

*Indoor visits: Limit 2 guests. Individuals must remain in the resident's room. Please use the resident call-light if in need of assistance.

*ALL individuals must enter the facility to be screened.

*A surgical mask must be worn at all times inside.

*Visit duration is recommended to be limited to 45-60 minutes.

*Individual Patients on quarantine are not permitted visitation until "cleared" per RIDOH guidance.

*No guests can walk about the facility or on the units.

As we enter the Memorial Day Weekend, I wish to take a moment to remember our Veterans, and the families who treasure their legacy of service. I hope you are all safe and, as always, wish you all good health!
