Aman Nanda, MD, CMD, AGSF is an Associate Professor of Medicine at Alpert Medical School at Brown University. He came to Brown in 2001 after completing his one year Fellowship in Geriatric Medicine from St. Louis University School of Medicine followed by two more years as a John A Hartford Fellow in Geriatric Medicine and Clinical Epidemiology from Yale School of Medicine. He has been the Program Director of the Geriatric Medicine Fellowship Program at Brown since 2006. He is a clinician, educator and researcher. His research interests are: dizziness in older people, nursing home care and medical education. He is also Director of Geriatrics Ambulatory Care and Home Care Program. He has served as the Medical Director at Steere House since 2002.
